

COVID-19 protection concept, FIS/EC Alpine Skiing race (SUI), 2020/21 season, applicable from 20. December 2020

<p>Hygiene measures and code of conduct issued by the Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH) / the Federal Office of Sport (FOSPO) / Swiss Olympic</p>	<p>Masks must be worn if it is not always possible to comply with social distancing rules. Close contact is defined as contact that lasts longer than 15 minutes or repeatedly falls below a distance of 1.5 meters without protective measures. https://www.bag.admin.ch/bag/en/home.html</p>
<p>International teams</p>	<p>The current rules for persons arriving in Switzerland apply to international teams, for quarantine rules, see FOPH; https://www.bag.admin.ch/bag/en/home.html</p>
<p>Prevention</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health takes the highest priority; a high level of solidarity and individual responsibility is required. • Persons with COVID-19 symptoms must refrain from attending the event. • The OC and Swiss-Ski must be informed as soon as possible if COVID-19 is diagnosed after the event (within 14 days).
<p>Information</p>	<p>The posters and codes of conduct issued by Swiss Olympic, the FOSPO and the FOPH will be displayed</p>
<p>Arrival and departure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individually by private car/the team's own bus • The wearing of masks is mandatory if arriving on a team bus (distancing rule). • FOPH rules must be complied with if arriving by public transport.
<p>Accreditation/team captain information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The team captain shows up to the race office at the specified time. He delivers the list (page 2) with the names and telephone numbers of all people present (athletes, coaches, service, etc.) with their signature, which confirms that everyone is arriving symptom-free. In addition, he will present a medically confirmed antigen or PCR test from each person that is not older than 72 hours. This is the only way to get accreditation and lift tickets for these people. • It is mandatory to wear a mask at Team Captains Meetings (TCM). • Access to the competition area is only permitted by registering the QR code via the Mindful app. https://mindfulapp.io/#download • The OC will appoint a COVID-19 Safety Manager who will inform the team captains about the protection concept Each team is responsible for ensuring that the information is circulated within their team and for compliance with the protection regulations. • Visitors have no access to the competition area
<p>OC registration</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All participants (OC, officials, volunteers, media) must register via the OC. The registration list must be stored until 14 days after the event.
<p>Accommodation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In accordance with FOPH guidelines for the hotel industry.
<p>Food/meal times</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In accordance with FOPH guidelines for the hotel industry and the respective catering provider/institution.
<p>Conduct at the competition site</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registered team members can access the competition grounds subject to compliance with the applicable codes of conduct and protective measures. Access control in consultation with the OC. • Social distancing rules must be observed at the start area, at course inspection and at the finish area and the wearing of masks is mandatory.
<p>Start numbers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start numbers are deposited at start number stands and must be personally collected and returned.
<p>Award ceremony</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks must be worn during the award ceremony.
<p>Communication</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All registered teams will be contacted by the OC at their registered address and sent the programme and protection concept.
<p>Protective equipment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All participants and visitors are responsible for their own protective equipment (masks, disinfectants) and will bring these with them themselves.
<p>Contact tracing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The list with contact details of team captains must be stored until 14 days after the event and must be identifiable at the request of the cantonal health authorities. • Registration takes place via the Mindful app. https://mindfulapp.io/#download. The QR codes will be displayed at the entrance to the competition site. • Swiss-Ski recommends downloading and activating the "SwissCovid" app
