# GENERAL PRINCIPLES


New coronavirus Last update: 29.10.2020

**PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS** ✓

## STOP CORONA

- Get together with fewer people.
- Keep a distance.
- Masks compulsory if distancing isn't possible.
- Masks compulsory in publicly accessible indoor and outdoor areas, and on public transport.
- Work from home if possible.
- Wash your hands thoroughly.
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow.
- Do not shake hands.
- Ventilate rooms several times a day.
- Events: Public, max. 50 people  
Private, max. 10 people  
Gatherings in public, max. 15 people
- If you experience symptoms, get tested immediately and stay at home.
- To enable contact tracing, always provide your complete contact information.
- To break infection chains: download and activate the SwissCovid app.
- If you test positive: isolate. If you have had contact with a confirmed case: quarantine.
- Only visit a doctor's office or an accident and emergency department after making an appointment by phone.

# Teams

(Athletes, ski team staff)

## Accreditation

Team captains present the complete list of all team members including following individual documents:

- Negative RT-PCR or antigene-test within 72 hours prior to accreditation (except athletes with previous COVID-19 infection: positive RT-PCR <3 months >2 weeks prior to the accreditation; no symptoms since >48h)
- Negative FIS questionnaire and signed registration form

Accreditation opening hours will be communicated to the team captains

No symptomatic person will be accredited

Any pre-existing prescribed isolation or quarantine has to be completed before accreditation

# Staff

## Accreditation

Please present:

- Negative FIS questionnaire and signed registration form
- There is no legal obligations to undergo a RT-PCR or Antigen Test (subject to change without notice; according Swiss Ski Concept EC)

No symptomatic person will be accredited

Any pre-existing prescribed isolation or quarantine has to be completed before accreditation

Accreditation opening times will be communicated individually by e-mail

# „Protocol to follow“ for: Symptomatic cases – positive cases – contact cases

## Symptomatic cases during the event

- Immediate isolation in a designated room
- Call Hotline +41 (0)33 856 66 86 and get remote consultation
- Rapid COVID-19 Antigen test
- Negative Rapid Antigen test: after a period of 24h without symptoms person may rejoin the event

## Positive COVID-19 test

- Immediate isolation in a designated room
- Isolation lasts for a minimum of 10 days and a period of 48h without symptoms
- Period of isolation cannot be abbreviated by negative test
- The COVID-19 task force will assist for further questions and arrangements
- No external communication ahead of release by COVID-19 task force

## Contact cases

- Immediate quarantine in a designated room
- Quarantine lasts 10 days
- In case of later occurring symptoms call Hotline +41 (0)33 856 66 86 and get remote consultation
- Period of quarantine cannot be abbreviated by negative test
- The COVID-19 task force will assist for further questions and arrangements
